## Update to the Committee

Condition 16 (included below for ease of reference) was included in error and is not enforceable, reasonable or necessary and fails the 6 tests from Paragraph 55 of the National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF 2021).

16. There shall be no more than an average, when measured over 1 year (1 April – 31 March) of 85 Heavy Goods Vehicle (HGV) i.e. those over 7.5 tonnes Gross Weight movements per day (i.e. 45 in and 40 out) entering or leaving the site.

REASON: To protect the amenity of nearby residential occupiers and to satisfy Hart Local Plan (Strategy and Sites) 2032 Policy NBE11 and Hart District Local Plan (Replacement) 1996-2006 and First Alterations to the Hart District Local Plan (Replacement) 1996-2006 Saved Policy GEN1.

The condition is not recommended for inclusion and should be omitted from the report.

Two further objection comments have been received raising concerns in respect of noise, pollution, loss of amenity and safety.

A meeting was held at the Civic Offices on Friday 14<sup>th</sup> April to discuss the proposals. Those in attendance at the meeting were:

At the start of the meeting Members confirmed they were there to listen to matters and would not be discussing merits of the application. The applicant's team set out what they were applying for, and why they thought it was necessary to amend the conditions.

The Members in attendance reflected on the reasons why the conditions had been requested in the original application. They also noted the strength of local feeling, and they had viewed the objections online.

All attendees agreed that Planning Committee is the correct place to consider the merits of the application.
