1 PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 To gain approval for the council to develop an opportunity for income generation at Edenbrook and Bramshot Farm Country Parks and to seek authorisation to release funding on an invest to save basis to develop premises for the concession.

2 OFFICER RECOMMENDATION

- 2.1 That the Council engages with the market to secure a suitable supplier to deliver a concessions business opportunity in Edenbrook and Bramshot Farm Country Parks.
- 2.2 That (subject to an approved business case) invest to save funding is released and earmarked within the Capital Programme for Countryside Services.

3 BACKGROUND

- 3.1 There is an opportunity for the Council to consider the provision of a location for a refreshments concession at one of our country parks to both broaden the number of visitors to the country park and also extend the time that visitors stay at the attraction.
