1. Council tax support - reduced number of band D equivalents in receipt of this from 23/24 to 24/25 - why is this?

The number grew in the pandemic and is now starting to fall again. The figures come from a data grab in October each year

We don't know exactly why but suspect more people are now falling out of eligibility due to employment, earnings and/or savings growth.

2. Regarding the new care leavers discount introduced in the budget setting council last February. What has been the take up so far?

At the time of the approval, we got our estimated take up from HCC who said it was likely to be very small. It is publicised on our website and HCC signpost it when people leave care. No one has applied since it was introduced at the start of the current financial year.
